

Working safely with a small deck crane

A crane operator moves loads with a small deck crane on board of a ship. The operator must work safely, responsibly and efficiently and must be able to communicate clearly with his colleagues. The participant will acquire knowledge of the safety aspects, lifting tools and fixing and moving loads on board. Furthermore, the crane operator takes care about the daily maintenance of the lifting installation. All these mentioned topics will be discussed in this course.

Content

Theoretical/practical

- types of cranes
- working safely and efficiently with a crane
- safety aspects of lifting tools (workload, test load, breaking force and usage factor) and certificates of lifting tools
- rejection criteria and visual inspection
- estimating the mass of loads
- safely fixing loads
- Working with radio, hand- and arm signals
- daily maintenance

Result

A practical assessment will be taken at the end of the course. The participant will receive a certificate if the assessment is completed successfully.
